The above compulsory charges cover the cost of **all** classroom materials, competitions, sport, excursions, off-campus learning (camps), and student dinners for Years 6, 10, 11 and 12.

**However there are some exceptions and these are detailed on the next page**

**Please note there is no refund for non participation in any school activity and Compulsory Year level curriculum charges apply to each student and are not discounted.**

### OTHER COMPULSORY ANNUAL CHARGES

- General Family Service Charge \$200 pa.
- Student Accident Insurance charge of approximately \$8 (not included in above levies) billed in March each year on a per student basis.

### ENROLMENT AND PRE-ENTRY FEES

- A non-refundable Enrolment Application Fee of \$80.00 per family is payable on application.
- A Pre-Entry Fee of \$1000.00 per family is payable for all 2010 enrolments on acceptance of a place. 50% of this will credited to the final account of the last child in their last year at the College. (Refer to item 3 in the Business Statement.)
- Students from overseas with Permanent Residency status applying for entry to Oxley College, should contact the Enrolment Registrar for application forms and details of the Application, Pre-Entry and other fees applicable.

### ITEMS NOT INCLUDED IN COMPULSORY YEAR LEVEL CURRICULUM CHARGES

- **Additional VCE (Year 11 and 12)** costs to the compulsory Year Level Curriculum Charges above are for a variety of other extra curricular activities in which VCE students may participate including excursions. These are billed to your account as they occur.
- **Private music students**, as well as being separately billed for private tuition, may be involved in additional extra curricular activities such as (AMEB) exams, music books, accompanist for exams or a music camp. These are all extra charges. Please refer to our music Policy and Procedures for full details.
- Our “**Before and After School Care**” program is an extra service and you should refer to specific documents included in your information pack for detailed information.
- Throughout the year students may be involved in extra curricular activities such as a **musical presentation**. These are not included in the Curriculum Levies and you will be advised throughout the year of any additional costs for these functions.
- Students in Year 8 and 10 may require a **specialist calculator** and the school is able to purchase these in bulk at a discounted rate. Information for these is provided at the beginning of each year and the costs can be billed to your account.
- Students chosen for the new Basketball Academy program will be billed an additional \$500 at 25% per term. As 2009 is the first official year of the program these costs may increase in future years.

### TUITION FEE DISCOUNTS

The following discounts apply only to tuition fees

- A 5% discount for each student where there are 2 students in the family
- A 10% discount for each student where there are 3 children in the family
- A 15% discount for each student where there are 4 children in the family
- A 100% discount for the 5<sup>th</sup> child
- In addition to the above discounts a further 5% discount is offered when paying 2009 annual school fees in a lump sum before the 5<sup>th</sup> of December 2008.

**Please note that no sibling student discounts are offered when students are in Kinderoo or Pre School.**

### BILLING CYCLES

- Term tuition fees and 25% of the curriculum levies will be billed each term (i.e. 4 times per year).
- Additional VCE costs will be billed as they occur.

### PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS

- **All payments are due 14 days after the Invoice/Statement** is issued **unless** an approved Direct Debit arrangement is in place.
- The school charges an administration fee of \$25 per occasion for dishonoured cheques, failed electronic payments, missed installments and late payments of account. In addition to this we will also pass on any bank charges associated with failed payments. To avoid being charged the administration fee you must keep our accounts office informed of likely delays in paying your account and keep sufficient funds in any accounts from which you have authorised direct debits.
- Payment of accounts by regular direct debit is available on request. Payments commence in February and finish at the end of October each year. If you would like more information about this method of paying school fees please call the office on (03) 9727 9900 .
